Riverside Resort Guidelines

Booking

Reservations taken year round.

Our booking policy limits reservations of Tent & RV sites to age 21 years or older, and Cabin & Yurt rentals to age 25 years or older. Valid CC must be produced upon check-in and ID may be required to verify age.

Cancellation

If more than 14 days' notice is given, a \$20 administration fee will be charged.

Less than 14 days' notice to cancel will result in the original deposit being forfeited.

Cabins/Yurts

If more than 30 days' notice is given, a \$20 administration fee will be charged.

Less than 30 days' notice to cancel will result in the original deposit being forfeited.

Deposit

Deposit taken upon booking reservation via credit card.

Payment Method

Visa, MasterCard, Debit & Cash. All rates are in Canadian Dollars.

Deposit Structure

1-2 nights: 100% Deposit Due 3-14 nights: 50% Deposit Due 15+ nights: 30% Deposit Due

Minimum Stays

All Year Round

RV & Tent Sites - 1 night minimum Cabins & Yurts - 2 night minimum

Check In / Check Out

Check In 1 PM Check Out 12 PM Yurt/Cabin Rentals Check in 4 PM Check Out 11 AM

The showers at Riverside are on a paid basis and cards can be purchased during office hours only. To purchase a card please see the resort hours and visit the laundromat.

Vehicles

One vehicle per site only. Additional charges apply for additional vehicles.

Tents

Tents permitted in the Multi Use & Walk in Tent area of the Resort only.

Pets

Pets are allowed. Charges are applicable based on Upper or Lower areas of the Resort.

Campfires

Open wood burning fires permitted, unless a Fire Ban is imposed. Please check signs at the Resort to confirm whether wood burning or propane fire pits are permitted.

Quiet Time

11 PM to 8 AM daily.

No Smoking

The use of tobacco and marijuana (including e-cigarettes and vapes) is not permitted in public areas of the Resort (on the beach, common areas, resort buildings or rental cabins / yurts). Where designated smoking areas do exist, they are restricted to tobacco only.

Rate Structure

Based on Two Person Occupancy. Limit of 6 people (18+ years) per site. Children under 6 years old are free.

Internet Access

We offer free wifi that can be used for low bandwidth activities such as checking email, Facebook etc. Please be aware that streaming videos or music may slow your connection and may cause a loss of connection.

Visitors

Visitors and non-registered guests are welcome to park their vehicles on Riverside designated visitor parking areas only.

Wildlife

All wildlife attractants must be stored in provided bear-proof enclosure or in a secured vehicle, cabin or yurt when leaving site or retiring for the night. Attractants include, but are not limited to: food, garbage, recycling, empty containers, coolers (full or empty), dishes (clean or dirty), stoves and all scented items (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, etc.)
